Preschool Graduation Information - Please SAVE these reminders!

- 1.) Preschool Graduation will be held on Wednesday, May 21st, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. in the West Grand High School auditorium.
- 2.) Dress rehearsal will be at 2:00 p.m. on the 21st. We will ride the bus, please sign permission slip for your child to ride.
- 3.) Arrive at the high school at 6:10 p.m. on the 21st, take your child to the bathroom and to get a drink **PRIOR** to leaving your child with a staff member.
- 4.) Leave your child with preschool staff at **6:10 p.m.** on the 21st, take a seat and prepare to enjoy the show.
- 5.) After the program, you may keep your child's tassel from their cap. All caps and gowns must be returned to staff.
- 6.) Please, no snow boots or 'clumsy' shoes since the children will be walking on the risers.
- 7.) **GIRLS:** No high ponytails, big barrettes or head pieces that could interfere with her graduation cap.
