Please leave the "to" line BLANK. This way your child may walk around and put one card in each classmate's bag and not have to ask who to whom that card belongs.** If you would like to bring snacks/treats or help, a sign-up sheet will go out next week on ParentSquare. to attend, we always need help serving and cleaning up! If your child does not normally attend school on Wednesday's, you may bring your child to the party and stay with them through the festivities!



Important Reminder - I am coming to you all asking for your help. The Kremmling Preschool is a guest in the K8 school building and we work hard to respect the district's policies. One of those policies is the school district limits access to their buildings for several reasons, the biggest being security purposes. For us at the preschool, we must have an adult, 18 or older, sign in/out the preschoolers (this is a licensing rule from the State of Colorado). The district works hard to accommodate our needs and has made an exception to their rule and allows our preschool parents to walk their child to class. My ask is that we all be mindful of the districts policies and do our best to respect and follow the rules. What does this look like for us when dropping off? Please remind your children to stay with you, using their walking feet and inside voices, check in at the front office & grab a visitor pass, come straight to/from the preschool rooms, making stops only for restroom use or to check in/out at the front desk. I know the temptation is strong to stop and hangout by your older child's classroom, maybe waiting for them to come in from recess or checkin to see how they are, but the district has asked that we follow their rules so I am asking for your help in doing this.
